

“Highlighting the lag in education's data insights, she suggested a government focus akin to the financial sector. Trends like AR, VR, AI, 5G, and robotics were discussed. In her conclusion, she focused on building a digital ecosystem, questioning teacher readiness for tools, advocating for ed-tech partnerships to expand educators, and proposing AI and AR to cut costs and benefit the entire system.

“At our institute (ICSI), we incorporated AI into our curriculum during the recent syllabus update, acknowledging its integral role in the future. Recognizing the importance of adapting to AI, we see it as a key factor for our success.

“Expressing gratitude, the speaker emphasized the increasing reliance on computers and AI for academic solutions. They highlighted the importance of understanding data sources and sizes, advocating for the right data use. While valuing AI, the speaker emphasized its complementarity with human intelligence, underscoring the irreplaceable role of classroom teachers. The use of AI tools for tutorial classes to enhance individual learning experiences was also discussed.


